Electrical Substation for Garrison Oak Business and Technology Park \$5,000,000

City of Dover – Dover, Del.

The purpose of this project is to construct an electric substation that will increase the City of Dover's overall power supply to support economic development and specifically provide electricity to the 126-acre Garrison Oak Business and Technology Park.
