In 1979, in the midst of the Iranian Revolution, Iranian students stormed the U.S. Embassy in Tehran and took fifty-two Americans hostage for 444 days. Four decades later, the Iranian government continues to hold at least thirteen foreign nationals, including several with Iranian citizenship, captive. To draw attention to their detention and discuss how we might be able to help secure their release, the Senate Human Rights Caucus will host a discussion with a former hostage and the family members of American and British citizens who remain detained in Iran.
